



TELECOMMUNICATIONS & DIGITAL ECONOMY COMMITTEE 2-YEAR PROGRAM

1. PRIORITY (topic) Further Growth of Telco Industry and Digital Infrastructure

Telco:

- Adoption of new Electronic Communications Law in Q1 2023 (as announced by the Prime Minister):
 - o Introduction of electronic bills as default form of bill for all customers
 - o Securing digital contracts and abolishing individual base station permits
 - o Clear legal basis for functioning of Credit Bureau with bi-directional exchange of information between telcos and banks.

Goal:

Digital Infrastructure

- Shaping Draft Broadband Law to secure open access to infrastructure of public utilities and alignment with EU Cost Reduction Directive.

5G:

- Advocating for **5G Spectrum Auction** terms to enable sustainable, fast and proper implementation of 5G in Serbia.
- 5G auction in the first half of 2023
- Adoption of the Bylaw on minimum conditions and auction conducting

Telco – Continuation of advocacy within Government Working Group on Draft Electronic Communication Law.

Digital Infrastructure – Participation in Gov WG on Draft Broadband Law.

Proposed activity:

5G – Cooperation and dialogue with Information and Telecommunication Ministry, RATEL and Government regarding Spectrum Auction.

- Partnership with **Faculty of Electrical Engineering on Scientific Study** that will address issues that need to be resolved as precondition to have 5G

2. PRIORITY (topic) Fully Paperless interactions between the businesses and Government

Goal:

- Wider Adoption and Utilization of Gov eID & Cloud signature in private sector.
 - **Automatic data exchange between private sector and public entities** aimed at higher efficiency and fraud prevention (ex. banks & insurance institutions with Tax Administration).
 - **Introduction of new eGov services** such as sick leave notice for employer.
